

# **Liquorice Park policy for Entertainment/Events within the Park**

## **1. Background**

The Trustees encourage community activities within the park and have approved activities such as Shakespeare in the performance area and art displays and events across the Park.

Some concerns have been noted about the suitability of events in terms of them offending or causing alarm within the community. The trustees do not want to discourage people from holding events but ask them to abide by the following rules.

## **2. Rules**

All events must be suitable for all members of the community to view, including children. Thus, the event should not involve the use of violent or aggressive imagery or noise likely to cause distress to others.

The event should not involve discriminatory language or imagery and should comply with current Discrimination laws and not negatively portray any religion, gender or minority group.

Any event organisers should undertake their own risk assessments and insurance and understand that the organisers are wholly responsible for the event and its safe running.

All publicity should be shared and approved by the trustees before any publication.

## **3. Procedure for applying for permission to hold an event**

Requests should be made to a trustee in writing, confirming that they agree to abide by the above rules and to provide a summary of the event and what it entails. The trustees will then consider the request.

If a request is granted this will be communicated to the organiser promptly together with any conditions.
